
EVOLUTION'S MAGIC WAND

Time can't make the IMPOSSIBLE happen!





Water always runs downhill, never uphill




Left to itself, the whole universe would rur down. The earth and everything else would become cold and lifeless.


FIRE OR WATER? **GOD DOESN'T LIE!**
