Dr. Austin promotes new trail at key events

Your 7Wonders Creation Museum celebrated its 10th Anniversary by hosting Geologist Dr. Steven A. Austin for a series of events September 25th – 27th. The major purpose for sponsoring his trip from California was to help promote his proposed trail with a view of the "Little Grand Canyon of the Toutle." Ever since the eruption of Mount St. Helens and Austin's research of flow deposits quickly formed there, the 140 foot deep canyon has become a major interest to creationists around the world,

many of whom have expressed the desire to see it up close.

Austin presented his trail proposal (currently turned down by the Monument authorities) at a meeting of the Mount St. Helens Advisory Committee, a group mustered by Congressman Brian Baird to investigate whether or not the volcanic area should be under a new jurisdiction, that of the National Park Service

which is under the Department of the Interior. Under the current leadership of the U.S. Forest Service, funding has been limited and tourism has fallen off.

Austin excited members of the Advisory group with his enthusiasm for teaching geology at MSH, a place he proclaims as the only national site with a "breached dam" other than the Grand Canyon. He said he can teach from this one look-out how ten geological formations occurred. One Committee member even said Austin's presentation made him want to study geology.

Although Monument Director Tom Mulder stated that "the proposal has merit," he did not estimate its cost or indicate that the Monument would actively work towards making the trail a reality even though Austin said volunteers were willing to work on building the trail.

Austin also presented his trail proposal at a breakfast meeting of the 7Wonders Board of Directors, September 27th, that was open to the public. Over 40 people attended this kick-off of a gala affair that lasted the entire Saturday and hosted over 100 people.

The event not only marked the 10th Anniversary of the 7Wonders Museum, but also the completion of a \$30,000 outdoor improvement project (front page) that

includes an enlarged paved parking lot near the highway, a 65 foot concrete walkway to the new courtyard entrance with landscaping and lighting, and a stunning mural of the Mountain painted by Pauline Brunt of the Design Science Association, Portland.

Stan Lutz of Tacoma gave a 30 minute power point show of his pictures taken in Peru at a Museum housing authentic Ica Stones. The Stones, inscribed with figures of men interacting with dinosaurs, capture the

> imagination for how and where this ancient culture encountered them

Mark Plotkin, Cowlitz County Tourism Director, showed pictures of MSH taken from a flyover that can hardly be surpassed in their ability to show that Mount St. Helens is Awesome in scope and beauty even in its devastated state. Ask to see this on your next visit here. Return of life is present in many areas and large fish have been living in Spirit Lake.

Eruption Update: MSH expelled lava continuously into the crater from 10/04-1/08. The rate peaked at a dump truck load a second, but eventually decreased below the level of detection. During those 39 months 127 million cubic yards of volcanic rock were added to the crater. By comparison, the original lava dome was built between 1980 and 1986 and contains an estimated 97 million cubic yards of lava.

The crater is now about 7% filled by new lava. Meanwhile 28 years of landslides on walls forming the crater are producing a ramp from the crater floor to the rim. The public is not allowed in this dangerous, unstable area. Meanwhile the south face of the mountain is used for climbing, making MSH one of the most climbed mountains in the US.

Hours. Until the tourist season opens in May, the 7Wonders Museum is open Tuesday through Saturday 10 am to 5pm, unless away on business. Therefore it is best to call before coming. We are closed Sunday and Monday except by appointment. Call Doris at 360-274-5737 to schedule a visit or take your chances and drop by when you are in the area.

True beauty and why evolution cannot explain it

People vacation for various reasons, but most often they wish to see new sights--underwater corals and fish that dazzle with color or the magnificent fall leaves of the East Coast. Even the grandparent whose only wish is to see that distant grandchild will bask in how the baby has grown and matured. But when we go to heaven we will see the face of God which will be to see what no man is able to see without being dressed in the holiness obtained through faith in Jesus, the God-man who took our sins upon Himself at the cross. That will be true beauty.

I Timothy 6:16 tells us that God lives in unapproachable light which no one has seen or can see. Even Moses was only able to see the back of God when he met Him on Mount Sinai. It was the blind hymn writer, Fanny Crosby, who bade us look forward to "seeing God's lovely face some bright golden morning." In her blindness she leaned on Jesus, drew close to Him and understood more of what that might be like in

contrast to her darkness.

Often beauty is achieved here on earth through coverings: wrinkle cream, implants, face lifts, lipstick or hairpieces. Newly fallen puffy white snow is a pleasure to see when it covers the bare branches of

fall. And only when our sin is covered will we be truly beautiful because, essentially, "beauty is holiness without which no one can see God." We are told that when Christ shall appear we shall be like Him for we shall see Him as He is.

The astounding beauty of nature is a revelation of the character of its source, the Creator. And yet, the whole creation groans because of sin that affected plants and animals as well as people. Sin is the source not only of death but of all ugliness and disorder which has brought to us the problem of evil. Our free will to choose contrary to God's laws ushered in a time of learning the great chasm that exists apart from the beauty, holiness and order of God. The book, *Heaven*, by Randy Elcorn, has much to say about beauty because in Heaven God will take the old and make "all things new." He will reorder the disorder to a magnificent state where we will be amazed at what we can accomplish (not just playing a harp.).

Evolution tries to explain evil in the world through long-past environmental influences. Evolutionary psychologists believe we still have remnants of our "stone-age brains" operating. Yet, history records that great changes occur in society through revivals. Society cycles in a non-changing circle of events whereby we learn that "evil communications corrupt good manners," (I Corinthians 15:33). The first of the Psalms tells us that we are blessed when "we walk not in the counsel of the ungodly but delight rather in the law of the Lord."

The evolutionist cannot satisfactorily explain how beauty evolved because, as Kurt Wise points out in *Faith, Form, and Time*, every increase in mutational development will have had to occur by the necessity for survival. Beauty is not necessary in many cases for survival. It is simply the delight of the Creator and part of His nature to give us that. Therefore, as we see beauty in nature we must ask ourselves what it will be like to behold the face of God and to be in a place where our sin will no longer hide us from His lovely, glorious and majestic eyes—then to hear His voice which has been likened to the sound of many waters.

Therefore it must be that in 2009 we look even more

to Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is now seated at the right hand of the throne of God

Therefore, as we see beauty in nature we must ask ourselves what it will be like to behold the face of God and to be in a place where our sin will no longer hide us from His lovely, glorious and majestic eyes, and then to hear His voice which has been likened to the sound of many waters.

Research: New theory for climate change

The following explanation for climate change is a summary of what Dr. Larry Vardiman said in the November issue of Acts & Facts (<u>www.icr.org/article/new-theory-climate-change</u>). This follows his October article saying that CO₂ was unlikely to cause global warming. (<u>www.icr.org/article/does-carbon-dioxide-drive-global-warming/</u>. Vardiman, an atmospheric scientist, directed hurricane and cloud seeding studies for the US government before joining the science faculty of the Institute for Creation Research in the '90's.

Intense solar storms called sunspots were thought to influence the temperature of the earth. Historic charts of sunspot activity closely match global temperature change with a 92% correlation. But because no mechanism could be found, this lead was dismissed and the CO_2 solution was adopted. Now the evidence is growing that solar storms decrease cloud formation and through this mechanism have a major influence on global temperature change. At the same time, evidence pointing to CO_2 is weakening.

Clouds reflect radiant energy from the sun back into space. Fewer clouds = warmer global temperatures. It has been known that clouds form when water vapor collects on a nucleus—usually compounds of sulfuric acid. But now, Danish physicist Henrik Svensmark and colleagues have discovered another source of cloud nuclei—the cosmic rays that constantly bombard the earth from space. They ionize the air and cause electrons to become cloud-forming nuclei. When the sun is more active with electromagnetic storms (sunspots), it generates solar winds. These winds blowing past the earth actually carry away some of those incoming cosmic rays. Fewer nuclei = fewer clouds = hotter climate. (Continued on Page 8)


Many creation friends searched for openings

2008 produced a bumper crop of creation resources to delight and challenge Bible-believing Christians. Below are just a few. You may still find our previously published list on our web site.

Persuaded by the Evidence, Douglas Sharp & Jerry Bergman, 288 pp, \$13.99

True stories from Christians—each sharing his personal journey to find the biblical truth of a six-day creation. From scientists in the midst of complex research to youth ministers, and more, see how each began at a different point and place in his life to question the supposed truth of evolution and how faith and actual evidence led to his embracing a creation-based, biblical world-view. In their testimonies, you will read about their search for answers, often unavailable through their school, their church, or scientific knowledge—and how the discoveries they made have shaped their faith and changed their lives.

The book's organization of 39 chapters is especially helpful. Testimonies of 33 individuals, each 2-18 pages long, are followed by four "fathers" of modern creation and two biographies of brilliant intellectuals. AE Wilder-Smith crafted original arguments for creation and caused Richard Dawkins to avoid debates with creationists. Smith is one of only a few scientists who earned three doctorates in science. Mortimer Adler is considered one of the greatest thinkers of all time. His most notable work was with Encyclopedia Britannica. He opposed evolution all his life because it didn't make sense, came to Christ at the age of 82 and lived to be nearly 100.

Here is the genius of the book's organization. The table of contents names the person featured in each chapter with the scientific truth that persuaded him and a brief paragraph summarizing his story. Seeking answers for yourself? Look through the eight-page table of contents and discover the truth you have overlooked—and find yourself persuaded by the evidence.

A Closer Look at the Evidence, third revised printing, Richard and Tina Kleiss, (2006 but only discovered by 7WM in 2008), 385 pp, \$11.95.

Two public school science teachers collected the best arguments for creation over the years. Creation writer Bruce Malone edited them into 365 easy-to-read devotional nuggets. Each page has a separate nugget starting with January 1. A perfect way to learn most of the major arguments for Creation and the existence of the Creator.

Draws from 70 expert sources to show how 26 different areas of human knowledge confirm that God's word can be trusted as the basis for truth, guidance and

one provides easy-to-follow evidences.

Genetic Entropy and the Mystery of the Genome, Third Edition, John Sanford, 234 pp, \$16.99.

This edition adds new findings in brief "author's notes" confirming what the author wrote in 12/05 about the vast information in the genome and that the genome is rapidly decreasing in fitness.

The primary inventor of the gene gun, Cornell geneticist Dr. John Sanford, writes "since the initial writing of this book a series of dramatic new developments have been published, all of which powerfully reinforce its central themes. These developments include the demonstration of the nonlinear nature of the genome, the poly-functional nature of each nucleotide, the fact that the genome encodes much more information than was ever recently thought possible, and the nonexistence of "junk" or "silent" DNA."

In effect, Dr. Sanford says that no new scientific findings have required the changing of the text of the first edition. Rather, they reinforce the fact that evolution could not produce the genome even if it had all eternity. Further, they show that the genome is failing, not improving (the central idea of evolution). Speaking of the magnitude of this work Dr. Vern Bissell says, "If the RATE studies are a nail in the coffin of evolution, Sanford's book is a railroad spike." Dr. John Baumgardner says, "This book deserves to be read by every professional biologist". The newest edition includes a new cover, better formatting and 30 additional pages of author's notes and appendices.

Flood by Design, Michael Oard, 130 pp (8.5x11), \$14.99. At last, there is an easy-to-understand book describing the kinds of large formations that were produced by the receding waters of the Flood. The Flood increased in depth and violence for 150 days before God began to deepen the ocean basins. As water poured off the uplifting continents, two types of erosion processes—sheet erosion and channelized erosion—produced classes of formations that are found commonly all over the earth yet are not being produced today. Learn how planation surfaces, inselbergs, vertically walled valleys and pediments confirm the accuracy of the Bible in describing how the Flood raged on the face of the earth for several hundred days, rearranging its entire surface.

A year ago, Carl Froede (*Geology by Design*, 160 pp, \$14.99) described small formations better explained by the

Flood. Because of their outstanding value the 7WM is bundling these two books for \$20—1/3 of retail.

Your Guide to the Grand Canyon -- a different perspective, Tom Vail, Mike Oard, John Hergenrather, and Dennis Bokovoy, 190 pp, \$14.99. Discover the Canyon's wildlife, vegetation, fossils, geology, history as well as its adventure, mystery and witness to Biblical Creation. Dr. Andrew Snelling says "I wholeheartedly endorse this Canyon guide and can't recommend it highly enough."

Old Earth Creationism on Trial, Tim Chaffey and Jason Lisle, 207 pp, \$12.99. The claims of deep time have challenged the authority of Scripture and cast doubt in the mind's of our youth. If science is right about billions of years, the Bible is untrustworthy and must be treated like walking through a mine field. This book gathers together and updates the many previous efforts to address the error of old earth creationism. Crying Rocks Ministry, Sedona, AZ. Retired industrial technology teacher Guy Forsythe, M.S., with his wife, Cindy, mail a high-quality, full-color quarterly newsletter "Creation News Update" to every household in Sedona. He reports numerous examples of false propaganda by evolutionists together with marvelous new scientific discoveries confirming Biblical creation. He writes in issue #20:

It is right there on page 77 of outspoken American atheist Sam Harris's book, Letter to a Christian Nation (2008). Yep, according to Mr. Harris, human embryos have tails and gill slits. Svensmark and others have confirmed this mechanism in a cloud chamber. Further testing is planned. These scientists thought their work would be received warmly. Instead, they were met with scorn—the same kind of derision creation receives.

Radical environmentalists view the earth as fragile and easily harmed. God reveals that his creation is robust and that seedtime and harvest, winter and summer will continue until the end He brings (Genesis 8:22). They put nature first; God puts people first. If their plans for reducing CO_2 were implemented, the greatest hardship would fall on the earth's two billion poorest people. In fact CO_2 is the gas of life.
